regardless of whether the business, enterprise or activity concerned is of a commercial, charitable or community nature or whether it involves the handling or sale of food on one occasion only.

SECTION 3 - Swimming Pool and Spa Pool Requirements

The *Public Health Act 2011* state that where a swimming or spa pool is available for public use, the water must be disinfected by chlorine, or by an alternative method specified by the 'Standard for the Operation of Swimming Pools and Spa Pools in South Australia'. The regulations indicate that a swimming pool or spa pool will be taken to be available for public use if it is available for use by persons staying at a guesthouse.
